Dear Governor Spitzer:

This letter is being sent to you concerning the possible parole of Shuaib Raheem who brutally murdered a New York City Police Officer during an armed robbery.

On January 19, 1973, Shuaib Raheem, a participant in an armed robbery of a sporting goods store not only for money but more so for weapons to inflict further violence, took aim with a high powered rifle and murdered Police Officer Stephen Gilroy, a member of the New York City Police Department Emergency Services Unit.

Police Officer Gilroy, 29 years old, an eight year veteran of the N.Y.P.D. was married for three years at the time of his violent death and his wife, Patricia was left to continue her life without her husband of only three years because of the fatal violence inflicted upon her husband Stephen by Shuaib Raheem that night.

Shuaib Raheem was considered for parole in November of 2007 until public outcry blasted the Parole Board for not notifying Police Officer Gilroy's family members to have an opportunity to give victim impact statements before voting in favor to release this cop killer.

It is respectfully requested that you intercede in this important matter and ensure that this murderer of a police officer remains in prison for the rest of his life.
